

Aqua One MariSys 240 Pro Series 2

The second product, the **Aqua One MariSys 240 Pro Series 2**, is a really useful bit of kit, allowing you to add a sump to any non-drilled tank and realise the benefits of remote skimming and filtration.

Skimmers can be obtrusive on the tank edge, so by having a means of running it underneath the aquarium you can have a large, powerful skimmer yet run it out of sight.

The Series 2 combines skimmer, return pump and mechanical and biological filter all housed in a compact, plastic sump with lid. Water is fed to the sump via a self-priming weir box that doesn't need the air pump like the 240 model.

The skimmer pump is upgraded too, from air powered to pump powered and the system is rated to skim and filter aquariums of up to 240 l/53 gal capacity with a maximum flow rate being fed back into the tank of 960 l/212 gal per hour.

Total power consumption is 59w and all filter media and pipework is supplied to enable quick set-up. The weir box will stretch over a 40mm stress bar if need be and has adjustable intake height.

There isn't much about with

which to compare this unit, despite being incredibly useful, and we would have thought it much in demand by those wanting to retrofit a marine sump to an existing off the shelf freshwater tank set-up.

Tunze makes the compact Skimmer Kit 15 which is great, but with the overflow box (not supplied) you're looking at more than £600 RRP, as opposed to under £300 from Aqua One.

All in all, this is a solution to a common problem and a much needed bit of kit. This new version is better than the old model too.
